GEORGE M. LAMBERT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM INSTRUCTION SHEET

(PLEASE READ CAREFULLY AND RETAIN FOR FUTURE INFORMATION)

The George M. Lambert Scholarship Program was originally established to encourage college students to enter careers oriented toward labor unions, specifically legal and public relations professions. Later, it was determined that all students should be encouraged to work hard toward whatever their career goals are.

Who is Eligible

Members of Pipeliners Local Union 798; their spouses, sons, daughters, and grandchildren who have completed high school and are **currently attending college full-time**. Full-time is considered a minimum of 12 credit hours completed in a Bachelor's degree program or a minimum of 9 credit hours completed in a Graduate degree program. Full-time enrollment requirements for applicants attending a quarter system college will be determined by the number of hours or courses that the applicant's college considers to be full-time attendance.

Scholarships Awarded

(10) \$3,000 General Scholarships and (1) \$7,500 Harry H. Faucett, Jr. Memorial Scholarship will be awarded to the highest-ranking applicant of the George M. Lambert Scholarship Program, provided the applicant has maintained an overall 3.2 GPA in their college level classes while seeking a Bachelor's or Graduate Degree.

Application

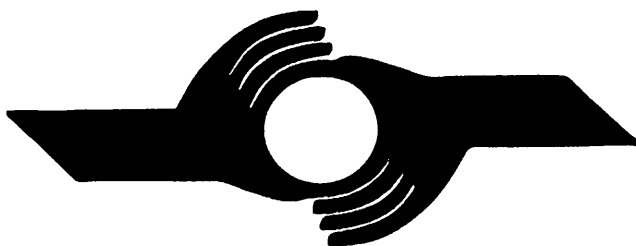
All applications for the 2023-2024 school term must be completed and submitted with their appraisal forms, official transcripts for the fall 2023 semester, and essay of 500 words or more, but not over 750 words, to the **Director of the Pipeliners Voluntary Fund at P.O. Box 470798 Tulsa, OK 74147-0798, no later than January 26, 2024**. Upon completion of the fall semester, it is the obligation of the student applicant to see that the Registrar of their college mails in an official transcript of grades by the cutoff date. Unfortunately, each year there are applicants disqualified because they did not follow up on this requirement.

How Winners are Selected

An outside screening committee will rank all applicants by considering academic achievement and potential of success in chosen field of study. Rankings will be presented in writing, with appropriate recommendations to the Pipeliners Scholarship Board.

Scholarship Recipient Requirements

Following the final selection, winners will be notified by mail to the address provided on the application. If you move, you must notify our office accordingly. **Each winner will be required to immediately submit three items, a brief background synopsis of all achievements, an appropriate 'Thank You' note, and a current photograph suitable for publication.** Upon receipt of all items from all scholarship recipients, the Scholarship checks will be mailed.
